



LEWISBURG RECYCLING SCHEDULE 2026

The following schedules pertain only to Recycling pickups by Greenworks for residences within Lewisburg city limits.

PICKUP SCHEDULE

Pickups begin the week of January 5th, 2026 and continue EVERY OTHER WEEK until 2027. One week ON one week OFF. Please see attached calendar. Pickups take place on your regular trash collection day, except as noted below.

HOLIDAY EXCEPTIONS

Holiday exceptions affect only the customers who fall directly on the holiday; the remainder of the week's schedule stays intact.

01.19.26 – Martin Luther King Jr. Day – Monday customers move to Tuesday.

02.16.26 – President's Day – Monday customers move to Tuesday.

05.25.26 – Memorial Day – Monday customers move to Tuesday.

09.07.26 – Labor Day – Monday customers move to Tuesday.

10.12.26 – Columbus Day – Monday customers move to Tuesday.

11.11.26 – Veteran's Day – Wednesday customers move to Thursday.

11.26.26 – Thanksgiving Day – Thursday customers move to Friday.

12.25.26 – Christmas Day – Friday customers move to Monday.

RECYCLING PROGRAM IN LEWISBURG

The City of Lewisburg offers free, curb-side recycling for all City residents!

RECYCLABLE MATERIALS COVERED:

- Plastics #1 – see-through water and soda bottles marked with a 1 or 01
- Plastics #2 Clear – translucent milk jugs and similar items marked with a 2
- Plastics #2 Color – color and non-transparent jugs, detergent jugs, etc.
- Cardboard – Corrugated cardboard, product packaging, paper egg crates
- Aluminum – Soda / beer cans, most cat food cans
- Steel – Soup / vegetable cans
- Newspaper – Matte, non-glossy newspaper
- Magazines – Magazines, brochures, glossy newspaper promotional inserts
- Office Paper – Printer paper, envelopes, letters
- Corded Electronics
- NO: Styrofoam / batteries / TVs / Plastics #3-7 / wrapping paper / tin pans or foil / greasy or waxed cardboard such as pizza boxes or paper milk cartons

All material types should be bundled or bagged individually if possible. Please thoroughly rinse all bottles, cans, jugs, and containers and remove all lids. Newspaper & office paper should be clean, dry, and placed in grocery bags or tied in bundles with twine (no wire please). Magazines and Cardboard may be similarly packed. Corrugated cardboard boxes need to be flattened. Cereal boxes need to have inside liners removed and be flattened. It is greatly appreciated!

Bags for plastic (yellow) and metal (orange) recyclables are available at 1108 Washington Street East or contact Greenworks for more info.

Due to a challenging economic climate - it has become very difficult and nearly cost prohibitive to recycle glass. Through creative partnerships, we are one of the last glass recyclers in WV and can offer glass recycling service for \$14/month. Payments may be made by cash, check or online using Paypal or a credit card.
